Recipients: Club Rotarians or others in the community

Award: Glass “plaque” and certificate  
\$250.00 donated to recipient’s choice of charity

Nominations: Club Member submissions with supporting documentation  
Deadline: April 30, 2009  
No limit on numbers of submissions

Selection: by the Vocational Committee

Presentation: May 2009

Criteria: Currently working within vocation profession  
Clearly demonstrated volunteer service related to own profession

Nomination: Completed Nomination Form, to include the following (*in addition to contact details, etc.*)

Contribution as a Vocational Role Model

- a) Tell us about the nominee’s specific vocational, volunteer service in their profession (what was done, who directly benefited and how, is it ongoing (for how long) or a single achievement, what is/was the time commitment, etc.)
- b) Tell us how the nominee’s activities have provided support, encouragement or education to those aspiring to that profession
- c) Tell us how the nominee has demonstrated vision, leadership or raised awareness of the profession as a whole, to the greater community
- d) How is this service outstanding, unique, or crucial? Does it include breaking new ground or old barriers, making a distinct difference or creativity? Does it provide an essential or vital service?
- e) Has the nominee’s service been recognized by their own profession? If so, in what way?
- f) How can others become involved if they wish to?

Format: Information not to exceed two type-written pages and must address each area. Use point form and provide supporting examples. Additional articles, photos, etc. should NOT be included.
